**2007**

Catholics are obliged to attend Holy Mass on the following holy days of obligation in 2007:

Thursday, November 1, <b>2007</b>	Feast of All Saints
Saturday, December 8, <b>2007*</b>	Feast of the Immaculate Conception
Tuesday, December 25, <b>2007</b>	Feast of the Nativity of the Lord

**2008**

Since the Feast of All Saints, November 1, **2008**, falls on a Saturday, there is no obligation to attend Holy Mass on this day. (Decree of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops, December 13, 1991)

Catholics are obliged to attend Holy Mass on the following holy days of obligation in 2008:

Tuesday, January 1, <b>2008</b>	Feast of Mary the Mother of God
Friday August 15, <b>2008</b>	Feast of the Assumption
Monday December 8, <b>2008*</b>	Feast of the Immaculate Conception
Thursday, December 25, <b>2008</b>	Feast of the Nativity of the Lord

Observance of the Feast of the Ascension is transferred to the Seventh Sunday of Easter.

\*The Monday-Saturday rule does not apply to the Feast of the Immaculate Conception or to Christmas.
